## The Weather of December.

The following observations were taken at Bucknall:—

Mean lowest temp. at Night 34.3; Mean highest temp. daily 43.8;  
Max. temp. of month (on 29th,) 51°; Min. temp. (on 25th,) 25°; Mean  
temp. of month 39.0; Greenwich mean 50 years 39.8.

Rainfall on 14 days 1.75in. Greatest fall on 1 day (28th,) .43in.  
Rainfall December, 1876, 4.80in.—1875, 0.99.

The daily direction of the Wind was as follows:—S. 6; S.W. 10;  
W. 4; N.W. 6; N.E. 3; E. 1; and calm 1 day.

The weather did not present any extraordinary features during this  
month being mild and open up to the 25th, when there was some frost,

The following observations were taken at Bucknall:—  
 Mean highest temp. daily 43.3; Mean lowest temp. at Night 34.4;  
 Max. temp. of month (on 27th,) 55°; Min. temp. (on 30th,) 26°;  
 Absolute Mean temp. of month 38.8; Greenwich mean 50 years 36.9.  
 Rainfall on 16 days 1.76in. Greatest fall on 1 day (27th,) 0.54in.  
 Rainfall January, 1877, 3.31in.—1876, 1.66.

The daily direction of the Wind was as follows:—N. 6, N.E. 2,  
 S.E. 2, S.W. 3, W. 8, N.W. 6, and calm 2 days; Mean force 2.4.

The month and year commenced fine, and with the exception of the

Absolute Mean temp. of month 41.7; Greenwich mean 50 years 41.6.

Rainfall on 11 days 1.12in. Greatest fall on 1 day (31st,) .25in.  
days of Snow, 6; Snow in ins. 9in; Rainfall Mar. 1877, 2.23in; 1876, 2.53in

The weather was mild and spring-like with only two frosty nights up to the 22nd, when 7 degrees of frost occurred at night, followed by snow on 24th; during the remainder of month there was a prevalence of Northerly gales, sharp frosty nights and heavy snows, especially on the 30th and 31st, on which latter date the thermometer descended to 20° at night, being extraordinarily low for this advanced period. The wind blew from a Northerly point almost uninterruptedly after the 7th day.
